Old Business: Randy gave the **Trails Group Report** and mentioned that we really, really need club members to step up and help the 16th and 22nd of August build-

ing trail. Saturday the 16th we need people to help remove vegetation and be trained as team leaders for the next weekend. Please bring gloves, axes and bow saws the first weekend and anyone you can find to help. We will need 5-6 team leaders to man 5 person teams the 22nd which will consist of moving rocks to even out the trail. We will require probably two small rigs with good winches, lots of snatch blocks, rock bars and plenty of helpers. We will NOT be moving rocks off the trail, just into the lower areas to even out the extreme off-camber parts. Even if you think there's nothing you can do to help, there will be work for you. We need water runners, branch trimmers, and will find work for all. Randy has been working on this for more years than most of us have even been wheeling and this is a VERY IMPORTANT project. We will be leaving the Sister's McDs at 8:30 a.m. both days.

New Business: Don't forget **Labor Day camping at Christmas Valley September 5th, 6th and 7th.** It is always a great time for wheeling and we will be celebrating Josh, Mia, and Zoe's Birthdays as well (like we need an excuse to celebrate). Motion was made for the club to pay for a porta potty out there for the club to use.

Randy will lead the next **club run**, August 30th. We will leave the Sister's McDs at 8:30 a.m.

The next club meeting will be September 13th at Travis and Margaret Lowe's (KemicalBurns) house and it

will, again, be a potluck. Bring your own drinks, meat to grill, and chairs.
